- All vehicles (aside from food trucks/trailers) must exit park gates NO LATER than 3:00 pm.
- Vehicles will not be permitted inside park gates until the conclusion of the last rodeo event on August 12th.
- Alcoholic beverages and tobacco products are prohibited.
- Vendors are responsible for the cleanliness of their spaces.

Participant Waiver:

The undersigned agrees to participate in the 2023 Rincon Rodeo on August 11th and August 12th in Rincon, Georgia. We agree to cooperate in every way possible and to abide by the established rules to ensure the safety and success of the event.
